MODULE 1: PROFESSIONAL GROOM

SANIP Certificate of Stable Yard Skills - Stage One

Entrance Requirements:

The **minimum** age that this assessment may be taken is year of birth 2001. In the case of applicants under the age of 18; permission must be obtained and confirmed in writing by the legal guardian.

Information:

The cost of the Module One assessment is R 1 650

The minimum pass rate for all subjects in this module is 70%.

Candidates will be assessed orally on their safe, practical application of knowledge with explanation.

Candidates are reminded that 10 marks will be deducted for failing to wear appropriate head gear when working with the horses at an assessment. Please remember to have your own string and not baling twine (plastic derivatives included), with you as required for tying up a horse using a quick release knot.

MODULE 2: PROFESSIONAL HEAD GROOM

SANIP Certificate of Stable Yard Skills - Stage Two

Entrance Requirements:

The **minimum** age that this assessment may be taken is year of birth 2000. In the case of applicants under the age of 18; permission must be obtained and confirmed in writing by the legal guardian.

Successful completion of Module 1

Information:

The cost of the Module Two examination is R 1 850

The minimum pass rate for all subjects in this module is 70%

Candidates will be assessed orally on their safe, practical application of knowledge with explanation.

MODULE 3: PROFESSIONAL STABLE YARD MANAGER

SANIP Certificate of Horsemastership

Entrance Requirements:

Successful completion of Modules 1 & 2 .

The **minimum** age that this examination may be taken is 18 years.

Information:

The cost of the Module Three assessment is R2 000

The minimum pass rate for all subjects in this module is 70%.

Candidates will be assessed orally on their safe, practical application of knowledge with explanations.

For certification of this qualification candidates must be in possession of a current recognized Level One First Aid Certificate.

**MODULE 4: Assistant Riding Instructor
SANIP Certificate – Assistant Instructor**

Requirements:

Successful completion of Modules 1, 2 & 3

The **minimum** age that this examination may be taken is 18 years.

Information:

The cost of the Module Four assessment is R 2 200

The minimum pass rate for all subjects in this module is 70%

For certification of this qualification candidates must be in possession of a recognized Level One First Aid Certificate.

Candidates are required to complete the EQASA Riding Proficiency Tests 1 & 2; signed off by a CEEPSA registered instructor before taking the module four assessment. Candidates in possession of Pony Club C+ or higher need not complete this requirement.

Teaching and riding logged records are to be signed off by a CEEPSA registered Level one instructor and given to the regional representative at the time of the examination. These logs can be found as downloads on the EQASA website.

A police clearance certificate is required for all instructors.

Please note: At the examiners' discretion the riding components of this module may be stopped/postponed if safety of participants or welfare of horses is in any way compromised.
